THE DYRSSSEN PRIZE FOR BEST SWEDISH MASTER THESIS IN THE MARINE SCIENCES

The Swedish Society for Marine Sciences appoints a yearly winner of the Dyrssen Price for the best Master's thesis within the field of Marine Science. The price sum is 10 000 SEK.

The price was founded by SHF to honor David Dyrssen, professor emeritus in analytical chemistry at the University of Gothenburg, who has actively worked to stimulate interdisciplinary collaborations within the marine sciences. He was one of the initiators of SHF.

Nominations to the Dyrssen Price is done by sending a copy of the thesis as a pdf file to the vice president Anna Wåhlin (anna.wahlin@gu.se), including name and address of the author and information about the university, department and supervisor. The thesis can be sent in by the author him/herself. The thesis should be approved by a Swedish university and executed within the field of Marine Science. The thesis should be at Master level, i.e. comprise 30-60 hp.

Registrations are accepted continuously. The price concerns thesis work approved between July 1st, 2010, and June 30th 2011. The winner and two runner ups are announced at the conference Havsforskningsdagarna which will be held on November 21st – November 23rd 2011 in Stockholm.
